Scholarship Notice

It is intimated that various Scholarship schemes (fresh and renewal) are available for students through **hpepass.cgg.gov.in** for year 2018-2019. Following points must be kept while filing the online application form:

- 1) Aadhaar card is mandatory to apply any scholarship scheme.
- 2) All documents uploaded must be in .JPG format, must have proper visibility and size should be within 80-100kB.
- 3) Previous years mark sheets (both semester) for renewal students and 10+2 mark sheet for fresh students should be uploaded.
- 4) Income certificate should be in the name of parents/Guardians and certificate should not be older than one year.
- 5) Students applying for renewal scholarships must upload latest bank statement of bank passbook and should submit the scholarship receipt of previous session to academic branch.
- 6) Scholarship amount will be transferred to the student's bank Account through DBT linked to Aadhar Card.
- 7) Hard copies of all documents uploaded must be submitted at academic branch.

It is further intimated that after due date no scholarship form will be entertained and students will be fully responsible for rejection of scholarship.

However the vacant seats in one category will be considered for another category.
