



Minutes of the first Meeting of the Board of Governors held on February 02, 2011 in the Committee Room of H.P. University Shimla

Item 1.1 **Statement of the Chairman**

"I welcome all the distinguished members to the first meeting of Board of Governors of the Technical University, Hamirpur. The Himachal Pradesh Technical University has been established by the Himachal Pradesh Technical University (Establishment and Regulation) Act 2010 (No. 16 of 2010). The objectives, powers, functions and salient features of the University are specified in this Act. In our endeavour to work towards these objectives we will have to set up infrastructure such as workshops, laboratories, classrooms, etc. Till we have the requisite infrastructure to set up academic pursuits, the University shall only be an examining body.

The first Board of Governors of the University has been constituted by the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Department of Technical Education, vide Notification No. EDEN (TE) A (1)-25/2009 dated January 07, 2011 for a term of three years. Professor Shashi Kumar Dhiman has been appointed as the first Vice Chancellor of the University by the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide Notification No. EDN (TE) A (1)-25/2009 dated January 07, 2011. He has joined the University on January 07, 2011 (F/N), and the University became functional with its headquarters at Govt. Polytechnic, Hamirpur.

The Govt. of HP has agreed to provide old SDM office complex for accommodating the camp offices of the university in the month of February, 2011 itself. The old SDM complex requires renovation which will be carried out of the University funds. It is proposed to hire accommodation on lease for guest house/transit accommodation, residence for the Vice Chancellor and Statutory Officers till residential units are built by the university itself. Here, I would stress that the Himachal Pradesh Technical University should not create a construction wing of its own, rather it should get the construction done through outside agencies.

Receipt of Grants from the Finance Department to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh. State Government has sanctioned and released an amount of Rs. 100 Lakh as interest free loan for the year 2010-11 vide letter No. EDN- (TE) C (2)-1/2010, dated January 17, 2011 to meet out the expenditure towards initial establishment activities of the University. Two saving Accounts (General Funds No.65105867438 and Withdrawal Account No 65106198736) in the name of the Himachal Pradesh Technical University have been opened with the State Bank of Patiala, on January 13, 2011.

Finance Officer has been declared as the Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO) and cheque signing authority in respect of all schemes in operation in the University. Govt.

has posted Sh. Jitender Mohan Awasthi as Finance Officer in the University as per its Notification dated November 29, 2010 and the officer has joined his duties on December 01, 2010.

I appreciate the provision of interest free loan to the University and hope that the Government will go a step further and provide free of cost land to the University for setting up its Campus as has been done in the case of Himachal Pradesh University, Central University, etc. I also want to impress upon the bureaucratic machinery of the state through the members of the Board of Governors to endeavor to facilitate the best environment to realize the thrust areas of the University."

Item 1.2 Purchase and Hiring of Vehicles for HP Technical University, Hamirpur

DECISION OF BOG: The BOG approved the purchase of Maruti SX4 on DGS&D rates for Vice Chancellor only. For other officers, instead of buying official vehicles, outsourcing of vehicles, as per the approved policy of HP government was recommended. It was approved that two vehicles i.e. taxis may be hired for the time being.

Item 1.3 Appointment of Assistant Registrar on contract basis and grant of emoluments to Assistant Registrar and scales/Salary on UGC pattern to Finance Officer.

DECISION OF BOG: The BOG approved the appointment and emoluments of Assistant Registrar. BOG pointed out that the Finance Officer has been posted on secondment basis in his own pay scale in the parent department and not in the UGC pay scale and he will be governed by the terms and conditions of his parent department.

Item 1.4 : Telephone allowance to the Officers of HP Technical University, Hamirpur.

DECISION OF BOG : It was decided to allow telephone allowance to the officers of the University as per the policy/ guidelines of HP Govt.

Item 1.5 Sanction of Permanent Advance to the following officers of HP Technical University for meeting out the contingent expenditure :-

Registrar	Rs 5000.00	For meeting miscellaneous contingency expenditure
Finance Officer	Rs 5000.00	For meeting miscellaneous contingency expenditure
PS/PA to Vice Chancellor	Rs 8000.00 (5000/+3000/-)	For meeting expenditure on fuel for office cars, postage, and to meet miscellaneous expenditure of Vice-Chancellor's office

DECISION OF BOG : The item was approved.

Item 1.6 Constitution of Spot Purchase Committee and Inspection Committee to procure the Items of requirement on DGS & D rates or HP Govt. rate contract. In certain cases where such rates are not available, constitution of Spot Purchase and Inspection committees

DECISION OF BOG: The item was approved. Need based committees will be constituted by the Vice Chancellor on the pattern prevalent in the Himachal Pradesh University.

Item 1.7 Adoption of Rules of Himachal Pradesh University Shimla for Various Administrative, Establishment and Service Matters till Framing of relevant Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations of the University.

DECISION OF BOG : It was decided to adopt HP University Rules. In case, there are no such rules then H.P. Government Rules will be adopted.

Item 1.8 Drafting of Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations to identify the thrust areas of the University.

DECISION OF BOG : The Vice Chancellor was authorized to constitute committees as per requirement.

Item 1.9 Designing of University Web Site

DECISION OF BOG : Item was approved. It was decided to launch website at the earliest possible.

Item 1.10 Admission for academic session 2011-2012 to all branches of Engineering, Information Technologies, Pharmacy in first year of Bachelor Degree Programs and printing of Handbook of Information 2011-12.

DECISION OF BOG : Director, Technical Education, HP stated that process of admission for Academic Session 2011-12 has been initiated by the Directorate of Technical Education, HP, Sundernagar and the work for publishing the handbook of information has already been started. Therefore, keeping in view the Director's statement, it was decided that all admissions and publication of Handbook of Information for academic session 2011-12 will be done by Director, Technical Education, HP as per past practice.

Item 1.11 Affiliation process for B. Tech, M. Tech, and various specializing programs in Engineering even at B. Tech. level, ICT programs (B. Tech (ICT), B.Sc. and M.Sc. (ICT)), BCA, PGDCA, MCA, MBA, BBA (various specializing programs), B Pharmacy, M. Pharmacy, BTA, MTA, B. Tech. (Management and Tourism), Program in Arts, Fashion and Designs.

DECISION OF BOG : It was approved that :-

- Secretary Education will issue a Notification that Himachal Pradesh University will transfer the record to HP Technical University with some specific date and till that the present system will continue ;
- That that HP Technical University will develop the relevant formats and its terms and conditions and, process the applications for the affiliation of technical education institutions.

Item 1.12 Compliance report format of affiliating of Colleges

Academic audit cell

DECISION OF BOG : It was decided to have compliance report formats of the AICTE and raise Academic Audit Cell within the HPTEU for which requisite back-up system would be put in place.

Rules & Regulations

GENERAL RULES FOR THE STUDENTS

1. Students are required to maintain discipline in the Institution and to follow the instructions given by the administration from time to time in letter & spirit.
2. Any student who remains absent from the class for one lecture/period shall be fined Rs. 5/- per lecture/period. For full day absence a fine of ₹25/- per day will be charged.
3. Any student who remains absent for more than 10 working days continuously without prior intimation, his/her name will be struck off and will be allowed re-admission by the Principal after being satisfied by the reason of absence submitted by the student. An amount of Rs. 1000/- shall be charged from the student on.
4. Use of mobile in the classroom is strictly prohibited. Strict action may be taken against the defaulter student.
5. Ragging, inside/outside the institution, is an offence. As per the Himachal Pradesh Educational Institutions (Prohibition of Ragging) Act 2009, every offence under this act shall be cognizable, nonbailable and compoundable with the permission of Court. If any student is found indulging in ragging activities directly or indirectly, strict action will be taken against him/her as per law.

Discipline and Conduct of Students

- a. All Students are under the disciplinary control of the Director and must to the rules of the College. Absence from lectures, tutorials, practical, workshop and sessional test without previous sanction will be viewed very seriously and disciplinary action will be taken against such defaulter. Breach of rules, misconduct, poor attendance or idleness will render a student liable to fine, expulsion or other disciplinary measures which the Director may deem fit. Such action is also likely, if in the opinion of the Director reasonable progress and application in work and studies are not being shown by the student.
- b. All the students are directed to dress-up properly in the Institute. All students are required to carry their Identity cards during institution hours.
- c. While undergoing practical training, students must conform in every respect the rules of the department's establishments in which they are taking training.
- d. Students who will be absent for seven days consecutively without any notice, either from the Institute or from practical training may not be allowed to attend class until a satisfactory explanation is submitted by that student and accepted by the authority.
- e. Students desiring to leave the Institute permanently must apply in writing and such application must be supported by written consent of his/her parents or guardian.
- f. Students are strictly forbidden from forwarding applications; appeals or any other communication direct to any authorities other than the Director and any contravention of this rule will make them liable to disciplinary action.
- g. Students are permitted to form only such associations or clubs (recreation or otherwise) at the institution as has been regularly approved by the Director and for which sanction must have been read at the beginning of each new academic session. All associations must be open to membership regardless of religion, community or political ideology. In no circumstances any association, the object of which is directly or indirectly communal or political will be permitted at the Institute campus.
- h. Students claiming benefits/concession on medical ground are required to submit medical certificate from government hospital or dispensary. The certificate should be submitted within a week of re-joining the Institute after illness, by the student concerned.
- i. Any student found under the influence of intoxication of drugs/alcohol in the Institute campus is liable to be taken strict disciplinary action against his / her, which may lead to expulsion from the college.
- j. The name of the student who fails to submit the University Examination Form for the semester in which he has been studying shall be removed from the rolls of the institution.
- k. Students are advised to regularly check the notices displayed on the Institute notice boards. The notices displayed on the various notice boards are deemed to have been served on the student.
- l. Director's decision in all matters will be final.

Leave and Attendance

- a. Students are expected to attend all classes and practical training regularly. While a student is undergoing practical training outside the institution, the leave will be sanctioned by the concerned according to the rules.
- b. All students will be subject to the attendance rules of the Haryana Pradesh University as laid down from time to time, which is 75% at present.
- c. Leave of absence will be granted at the discretion of the Director. Students absenting themselves shall be fined or disciplinary action will be taken against them. Student suffering from any infectious disease will not be permitted to attend the institution. No student who has been absent on grounds of illness for a period of ten days or more will be permitted to attend the classes until he/she produces medical fitness certificate.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- a. In an academic year there will be Two Semester Examinations. Minimum 75 percent of the attendance in each subject is necessary for a student for being eligible to appear in the examination of any subject.
- b. Besides this, the student must carry out and acquaint themselves with the laboratory and practical work covered during the semester to the satisfaction of the Director. Students are required to pursue their studies regularly and those whose performance in the class is not satisfactory are liable to be detained by the Director from appearing in the University Examinations.
- c. All students are expected to keep abreast with the studies and regularly pass the various University Examinations. The Detailed rules & Syllabi of the University Examinations are available with the institution and every student is advised to get the latest copy of syllabus for guidance.
- d. Absence from any examination will be considered a failure, no medical certificate or evidence of sickness during or prior to the time of examination will exempt a student from any examination.
- e. Strict action will be taken against the students who found using unfair means in university or other examination, as per H.P. University, Shimla rules.
- f. In addition to the University Examination, Sessional Tests are to be held during the Semester to enable the teaching staff to gauge the progress of individual student and marks obtained during these sessional tests will count towards marks to be awarded in the internal assessment of the student.
- g. General fitness forms a part of sessional work for all the Engineering Examinations of the University and success in these is as obligatory as in any other examination. Marks are awarded on the basis of performance of students in sports, physical fitness, tutorial meetings, curricular activities, attendance, good conduct etc. Students are therefore advised to pay due attention to the various activities in the college.
- h. All students must pay their dues to the institution office/ university website well in time & before filling University Examination Form in every Semester. The defaulter students may not be allowed to sit in the Semester Examination in case College dues are not paid.
